RESOLUTION #03-2022

RESOLUTION IDENTIFYING THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR THE FIRE DISTRICT WILDLAND FIRE & FUELS PERSONNEL RESPONSE AWAY FROM THEIR OFFICIAL DUTY STATION AND ASSIGNED TO A CAL-OES EMERGENCY INCIDENT

WHEREAS, the Tahoe Douglas Fire Protection District, is a public agency located in the County of Douglas, State of Nevada, and

WHEREAS, it is the Tahoe Douglas Fire Protection District's desire to provide fair and legal payment to all its employees for time worked; and

WHEREAS, Tahoe Douglas Fire Protection District has in its employ, Wildland Fire & Fuels Division personnel which include Division Chief/Fuels Management Officer/Div Supt, Battalion Chief/Crew Superintendent, Captain/Crew Foreman/Fuels Management Officer, Captain/Crew Foreman/Mechanic, Captain/Crew Foreman, Engineer/Squad Leader/Fire Equipment Operator, Engineer/Squad Leader, Crew Member; and

WHEREAS, Tahoe Douglas Fire Protection District will compensate its Wildland Fire and Fuel's employees portal to portal while in the course of their employment and away from their official duty station and assigned to an CAL-OES emergency incident, in support of an emergency incident, or pre-positioned for emergency response; and

WHEREAS, Tahoe Douglas Fire Protection District will compensate its Wildland Fire and Fuel's employees overtime in accordance with their current Memorandum of Understanding, employment contract while in the course of their employment and away from their official duty station and assigned to an emergency incident, in support of an emergency incident, or pre-positioned for emergency response; and

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Tahoe Douglas Fire Protection District Board of Trustees that:

1. Personnel shall be compensated according to the Memorandum of Understanding, Collective Bargaining Agreement, Personnel Rules and Regulations, and/or other directive that identifies personnel compensation in the workplace.
2. In the event a personnel classification does not have an assigned compensation rate, a "Base Rate" as set forth in an organizational policy, administrative directive or similar document will be used to compensate such personnel.
3. The Tahoe Douglas Fire Protection District will maintain a current salary survey or acknowledgement of acceptance of the "base rate" on file with the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services, Fire Rescue Division.
4. Personnel will be compensated (portal to portal) beginning at the time of dispatch to the return to jurisdiction when equipment and personnel are in service and available for agency response.

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Upon motion of MURPHY, seconded by KIRSCHNER, the foregoing Resolutions were passed and adopted this 18th day of MAY, 2022 by the following vote of the Tahoe Douglas Fire Protection Board:
